Jewel-Osco Begins Plans for North Side

Jewel-Osco recently appeared before the Village Board and the Plan Commission to present conceptual site plans and building elevations for a new 62,794 square foot grocery store at the northeast corner of Route 47 and Reed Road. The new Jewel store will focus on fresh and prepared foods and will include a drive thru Osco pharmacy, a Starbucks coffee shop, a café, and a seating area. The cost for the north side project is

estimated at \$17 million and will bring 160 new jobs to the area. Jewel plans to open the new store in early 2019. The project will bring a much desired anchor tenant to the north side of town and is expected to spur additional economic development interest to this growing area of the village. In addition to the new store, Jewel also plans to invest \$1.5 million to renovate the existing Jewel.
