Old Business: Councilman Murphy gave an update on the Christmas Parade and said there have

been 45 letters to Santa in the North Pole mail box so far. Tracy Johnson said there are 122 parade entrants so far. John Stitchberry has been very helpful and supportive of the Town. Shane Walker will announce the parade. The proceeds from the festival of trees will go to the fire department.


