6:00pm Call to Order by Mayor Henry

Roll Call: Councilmembers R. Murphy, Cummings, Franz, E. Murphy, Cephas, Mayor Henry and Manager Avery

Approval of Agenda: Cephas motion, second Franz with the addition of 3 items. 5/0 for.

Mayor Henry gave an update on the possibility of using the fire department building for a community center. The could either trade property or purchase the property when the fire department builds a new facility. The Mayor and Avery met with Jana at Warwick to discuss the possibility of them selling property on Poplar Street to them. They were not opposed to the idea. Cephas asked the Mayor to continue with the idea.

Mayor Henry said he has been approached by 2 businesses that are each looking for a building of 4000 to 5000 square feet. There is a possibility of selling some property on Neilson Street.

Avery explained the changes that he is proposing for personnel rules and regulations. An outline of those changes is attached. The Council agreed that the changes are justified and Avery should continue to develop the wording and bring a draft back to the Council. One consideration that should looked into is if the use of medical marijuana would be allowed in the work place?

Cummings explained his proposed salary structure for the Council and Mayor.


