MINUTES OPEN WORK SESSION July 6, 2021

6:00 PM Call to Order by Mayor Henry

Pledge of Allegiance

Prayer – E. Murphy

Roll Call - Councilmembers present; Franz, E. Murphy, R. Murphy, Mayor Henry, and Manager Avery

Approval of Agenda: Motion E. Murphy, second R. Murphy, vote 3/0.

Avery described Zoning Text Amendment Ordinance 2021-7. Councilmember Cephas had agreed to introduce the Ordinance.

Avery explained the request from the fire department to help fund new rescue tools. The request was sent out to local businesses by the fire department. They are applying for a grant which would require 25% on their part, which would be \$10,500. E. Murphy suggested a donation in that amount.

Avery stated that the grant application that was submitted for tress and bushes for the Memorial Park was not approved. E. Murphy suggested putting service men banners on poles in the park as they are not allowed on utility poles. They could be incorporated in with the trees. Mayor Henry said he would not like anything that would take away from the view and suggested engraved bricks or stones instead.


