



NOTICE OF ABSENTEE VOTING

for the City General Election

Tuesday, November 2, 2021

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF KENTWOOD:

If you are a registered voter in the City of Kentwood you may obtain an Absent Voter Ballot from the Kentwood City Clerk's office.

To apply for an absentee ballot:

- Appear in person at the City Clerk's office; or
- Request online at www.mi.gov/vote; or
- Request in writing, as follows:
 - Request a form from the City Clerk's office at 616.698.9610 or elections@kentwood.us
 - Print an absentee ballot application found online at www.kentwood.us/elections or www.michigan.gov/vote
 - Submit a letter or postcard noting your full name, the election date, your registered address and mailing address, with your signature and date.

- You cannot obtain an absentee ballot on behalf of another voter.

The last day to apply for an absentee ballot by mail is Friday, October 29

You may apply for an absentee ballot in person on Saturday, Oct 30 from 7:00 – 3:00

You may apply for & vote an absentee ballot in person on Monday Nov 1, 7:30 – 4:00

City Clerk's Office Hours:

M-W-Th 7:30 – 4:30; T 7:30 – 6:00; F 7:30 – noon; Sat. Oct 30 7:00 – 3:00

Permanent Absent Voter List: The Kentwood City Clerk's office maintains a Permanent Absent Voter list. Permanent AVs are mailed an *application* for an absentee ballot prior to every election held in the City. If you choose to vote in person or decline to vote in an election, you may disregard the mailed application. The application must be completed and returned to the Clerk's office to receive an absentee ballot. To be placed on the Permanent Absent Voter list, make a request by mail, email, by phone, or in person, providing your name, registered address, and year of birth (*see contact information above*).

Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the Clerk's office.
