TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF KENTWOOD:

If you are a registered voter in the City of Kentwood you may obtain an Absent Voter Ballot from the Kentwood City Clerk's office.

To apply for an absentee ballot:

- Appear in person at the City Clerk's office; or
- Request online at www.mi.gov/vote; or
- Request in writing, as follows:
 - Request a form from the City Clerk's office at 616.698.9610 or elections@kentwood.us
 - Print an absentee ballot application found online at www.kentwood.us/elections or www.michigan.gov/vote
 - Complete and submit an absentee ballot application online at www.michigan.gov/vote
 - Submit a letter or postcard noting your full name, the election date, your registered address and mailing address, with your signature and date.

- You cannot obtain an absentee ballot on behalf of another voter.

The last day to apply for an absentee ballot by mail is Friday, May 3

You may apply for an absentee ballot in person on Saturday, May 4 from 8:00 – 4:00

You may apply for an absentee ballot in person on Monday May 6, 7:30 – 4:00

Permanent Absent Voter Ballot List: The Kentwood City Clerk's office maintains Permanent Absent Voter Ballot voters are mailed a ballot for every election. To be placed on the Permanent Ballot list, make a request by mail, email, or in person, providing your name, registered address, and year of birth, and including your signature (*see contact information above*).

Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the Clerk's office.
