



# NOTICE OF REGISTRATION for the School Millage Election Tuesday, May 2, 2023

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF KENTWOOD:

Please take notice that any qualified elector of the City of Kentwood who is not already registered, may register to vote in person at the office of the City Clerk, the office of the County Clerk, a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated State agency. Printable registration forms can be obtained at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the City Clerk. A qualified elector with a valid Michigan driver license or state ID may register to vote or update their registration address online at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote).

**Qualifications to register to vote:** A voter must be a citizen of the United States, resident of Kentwood, and at least 18 years of age on or before May 2, 2023.

The last day to register in any manner other than in person with the City Clerk is Monday, April 17, 2023.

After April 17, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency at the Kentwood City Clerk's office located at 4900 Breton Ave. SE, Kentwood, 49508 at the following times:

- Regular business hours:  
*M-W-Th 7:30 – 4:30; T 7:30 – 6:00; F 7:30 – noon*
- Saturday, April 29 hours: *7 am – 3 pm*
- Tuesday, May 2 hours: *7 am – 8 pm*

*Proof of residency, which must include applicant's name and current address, may be a Michigan driver's license or state ID, utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document.*
