### ABSENTEE VOTING – VOTE AT HOME

---

Join the Permanent Mail Ballot List and you will be sent a ballot by mail for every election, allowing you to vote your ballot at home. If you request to be on the Permanent Ballot List:

- You will be mailed a ballot for every election in the City of Kentwood
- By voting absentee, you can take the time you need to study the ballot and vote from home
- By voting absentee, you can avoid going to your voting precinct on election day
- Beginning in 2024, you may use an absentee ballot to vote in a precinct on election day or for early in-person voting (offered in state-wide elections only)
- Simply return your absentee ballot by mail or in person to the City Clerk’s office, 4900 Breton Ave., by 8 pm on election day
