City of Kentwood to Host No-Cost COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Provided by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services

Kentwood, Michigan, Nov. 29, 2021 – The City of Kentwood will host a no-cost COVID-19 vaccine clinic for adults and children Thursday, Dec. 9 at the Kent District Library – Kentwood (Richard L. Root) Branch, 4950 Breton Ave. SE.

The clinic – sponsored by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services – will offer COVID-19 vaccines, including booster shots, from 2-6 p.m. in the library's Community Room. The clinic will be open to all community members and no appointment will be necessary.

The Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines will be available to adults for first, second and third doses as well as boosters. The Pfizer vaccine will be available for children ages 5-11. Vaccine and booster eligibility is determined by the [current CDC guidelines](#).
