APPLICANT: Andrew & Barbara Terrien

CASE NO.: V-21-15

VARIANCE REQUEST: The applicant wishes to install a six (6) foot high privacy fence in the required front yard. Section 3.19.B.1 of the Kentwood Zoning Ordinance limits the height of the fence to three (3) feet. The requested variance is for a three (3) foot increase in height over the maximum allowed by ordinance.
