- · Process handgun permits and registrations
- Copy reports, collect the appropriate fees and issue receipts in accordance with departmental guidelines
- · Assist persons seeking the release of impounded vehicles
- Answer incoming telephone calls, answer inquiries and relay messages or redirect the calls as appropriate.
- File, locate or retrieve police incident reports, arrest records orother documents as directed.
- Assist with clerical duties, research and other tasks when so directed.
- · Assist officers of the department when requested.
- Assist in community relations events such as National Night Out and Citizens Academy.
- Assist Code Enforcement with property inspections and citations.
- Assist with fingerprinting of citizens for background checks and misdemeanor arrests.
