## Notices

**Fees:** The fee for processing and reviewing deferred plan submittals shall be an amount equal to 65% of the building permit based on the valuation of the particular portion or portions of the project. This permit fee shall be based on the building permit fee calculated according to OAR 918-050-110(2) and (3) using the value of the particular deferred portion of the project with a minimum fee of \$246. This fee is in addition to the project plan review fee based on the total project value.

**Deferred submittal definition:** For the purpose of this section, deferred submittals are defined as those portions of the design that are not submitted at the time of the application and that are to be submitted to the building official within a specified period. Deferral of any submittal items shall have the prior approval of the building official. The registered design professional in responsible charge shall list the deferred submittals on the construction documents for review by the building official. 2019 OSSC 107.3.4.2

### **Plans and documentation submittal:**

- Three (3) copies of plans and documentation are required
- Payment of the minimum fee (\$246) due at time of application
- Documents for deferred submittal items shall be submitted to the registered design professional who shall review them and forward them to the building official with a notation indicating that the deferred submittal documents have been reviewed and found to be in general conformance to the design of the building. The deferred submittal items shall not be installed until the design and submittal documents have been approved by the building official.
