## RESOLUTION NO. R-2020-10

### A RESOLUTION RENOUNCING RACIST VIOLENCE

#### RECITALS:

Let it be known by this Resolution that King City stands in solidarity against senseless death and racist violence in our Country. We stand in solidarity with peoples of color, regardless of race, creed, color, religion, or nationality in our uniform outrage and disgust over the racist violence and senseless deaths of George Floyd, Tamir Rice, Trayvon Martin, Antonio Zambrano-Montes, Eric Garner, Freddie Gray, Amilcar Perez-Lopez, Walter Scott, Sandra Bland, Jessica Hernandez, Ahmaud Arbery, Ruben Villalpando, and many, many more. We recognize that this is not just a Black problem, but a systemic racist problem affecting all minority groups and people of color in this country.

As elected and appointed officials designated to represent all peoples of King City and our surrounding communities, we recognize that this continuing pattern of racist violence, senseless deaths by force, and all these repetitious violent acts that have preceded and followed the death of George Floyd uniquely affects people of color with levels of pain, rage and fear that we may never know the full depths of.

We stand united in our support for the peaceful protest to the systemic violence that plagues our country. We stand committed to dismantling long-standing systems, programs, policies and practices that may have historically created obstacles to the success of people of color, members of ethnic groups, and marginalized groups.

Included within this commitment is our priority to listen to and work with marginalized community leaders and community organization groups who are led by those most directly affected by these violent practices. We will work with our Police Department, Court Systems, along with County, Regional and State Governments as we continue to seek a shared vision of protecting the sanctity of life and the rights of all residents of our City, County and State.

We pledge to extend our ongoing commitment to eliminating any practice or policy that has the effect of disproportionately harming those who are Black, Indigenous, People of Color or anyone who has been historically marginalized.

We say these things as an expression of love, support, and sorrow in the interest of calm and peace during this violent time, all the while acknowledging that the full measure of our success depends on the trust our community places in us through visible actions and leadership.

Peace be with you.

This resolution was PASSED and ADOPTED this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020 and takes effect upon passage.
