

Lake Isabella Right-of-Way Markings

If you would like to place markings in the Village's Right-of-Way to help identify the street for snow plowing, please do so according to the following conditions:

1. All posts must have some type of reflective marking.
2. All posts must be at least 3 feet back from the edge of pavement.
3. No strings, wires, or other items may be tied from post to post.
4. Posts may be no taller than 48 inches.
5. It is your responsibility to properly maintain your posts.
6. All posts must be of a breakaway material (wood, fiberglass, plastic), metal posts are not allowed.
7. Installation and maintenance of markers are done at the property owner's own risk and liability.
8. The Village is not responsible for markers placed in our right-of-way which may be damaged or destroyed due to traffic, snow plows, etc.
9. Markers shall be removed no later than April 30th annually.

Please be advised, that during winters with large accumulation, the Village may be required to push snow banks back from the edge of streets. Posts remaining may be damaged during this work. Please follow our Facebook page for updates so that you can remove your posts in advance.
