

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
CITY OF LINCOLN PARK  
PROPOSED SEWER AND WATER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS**

The City of Lincoln Park will hold a public hearing for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for sanitary sewer rehabilitation and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) loan for the City of Lincoln Park lead service line replacement and water system improvements program. The purpose of the meeting is to present the Clean Water and Drinking Water System Improvements and to receive comments from interested parties. The hearing will be held during the Lincoln Park City Council starting at 7:30 pm on **Monday, April 03, 2023**. Interested residents may attend the meeting at the City of Lincoln Park City Hall.

The purpose of the proposed project is to provide lead service line replacement as required by the Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) in June 2018 requiring all cities in Michigan to replace all lead water service lines. The project will involve water main replacement through a Pipe Bursting of the existing water main in sixteen (16) locations to upgrade the main in areas where scheduled road construction projects will be Commenced, this work includes upgrading valves and hydrants in these areas. The proposed project also include Replacement of Lead Water Service Leads in these sixteen (16) locations and in various streets throughout the city as required by the Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) in June 2018 requiring all cities in Michigan to replace all lead water service lines. The water service lines must be replaced from the city-owned water mains within the street to 18 inches inside individual houses. The estimated cost of all the projects is approximately \$18,983,880.00. The typical household user would see a rate increase of \$6.50 per month.

The purpose of the Clean Water Projects is to provide rehabilitation to existing sanitary sewers, pump stations, flow monitoring, and other necessary improvements throughout the city where structural defects, inflow and infiltration were identified during a city-wide sewer cleaning and television investigation program. Project construction will involve the rehabilitation of existing sewers utilizing trenchless technologies such as installation of cured-in-place pipe linings and sectional replacement of sewers by means of open cut excavation for those defects deemed too severe for trenchless technology to be utilized and improvement for the Emmons and Lincoln Pump Stations. The project will also involve cleaning and televising the sanitary sewer system and various other improvements to the sanitary sewer system deemed necessary for reducing inflow and infiltration and ensure continued reliability for the sanitary sewer system. The estimated cost of the project is approximately \$16,304,527.00. The typical household user would see a rate increase of \$5.50 per month.

Copies of the project plan detailing the proposed projects will be available for inspection by the general public at the Office of the City Clerk, 1355 Southfield Road, Lincoln Park, Michigan 48146, starting Thursday, March 16, 2023. Written comments received before the public hearing will close on **Monday, April 03, 2023, at 4:00 pm** and will be reviewed for incorporation into the final project plan.
