Snow Emergency Protocol Reminder

immediately removed from city streets. If cars are not removed they will be subject to being ticketed and towed at the owner's expense.

It is critical that snow plow trucks can clean the entire width of city streets to ensure safe travel and to make sure snow does not freeze to the surface after the storm has passed. LED Street Lights Installation Underway

DTE has upgraded street lights to LED's in the following locations:

- Southfield Rd. between Electric Ave. and River Dr.
- Fort St. between Cleveland Ave. and Champaign Rd.

DTE is in process of upgrading street lights to LED's in the following neighborhoods:

- East of Fort St. between Outer Dr. and Southfield Rd.
- West of Fort St. between Cicotte Ave. and Outer Dr.

These conversions are replacing mercury vapor lamps and high pressure sodium lamps that are highly inefficient and not environmentally friendly.
