- Household paints, stains, dyes
- Floor wax, floor care products, carpet cleaner
- Furniture polish, bathroom cleaners, stain removers, solvents
- Pharmaceutical Waste (**NON-CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ONLY**)
- Nail polish, glue
- Fertilizer, lawn and garden chemicals, pesticides
- Antifreeze, motor oil, gasoline, propane tanks
- Automotive batteries and dry cell batteries, fluorescent bulbs (all types)
- Fire extinguishers, smoke detectors
- Mercury thermometers, thermostats and elemental mercury



Electronics Recycling

- Computer CPU's, flat screen monitors, printers, keyboards, mice
- Cell phones, fax machines, copiers (No CRT TVs or CRT monitors)

BEGINS Monday, April 24th



Construction will include the resurfacing of Southfield Road, pavement rehabilitation, concrete curb repair, drainage structure adjustments and concrete sidewalk and ADA ramps.

A. During construction the Lafayette Boulevard intersection will be replaced with concrete resulting in its closure throughout the project.
