The Mayor and City Council have scheduled a town hall meeting to discuss the recent passage of new medical marijuana regulations by the State of Michigan, specifically, dispensaries and growing/processing facilities.

BEGINS Saturday, April 15th



Construction will include the resurfacing of Southfield Road, pavement rehabilitation, concrete curb repair, drainage structure adjustments and concrete sidewalk and ADA ramps.

The Lafayette Boulevard intersection will be replaced with concrete resulting in its closure throughout the project. Additionally, one lane on Southfield will be maintained in each direction at all times. EXPECT DELAYS. Work is weather permitting.
