Last September the Michigan legislature passed Public Act 281 that significantly expanded the types of medical marijuana facilities permitted under state law. Each municipality had to decide if they would allow medical marijuana facilities within their city limits by "opting in" or not allowing them by "opting-out."

This past Monday, May 15th, 2017 the Mayor and City Council, pursuant to Public Act 281 of 2016, opted-out of the provisions that would allow for the ability to grow, process, transport or provision medical marijuana within the corporate boundaries of the City of Lincoln Park.

The existing law for marijuana caregivers remains in effect.
