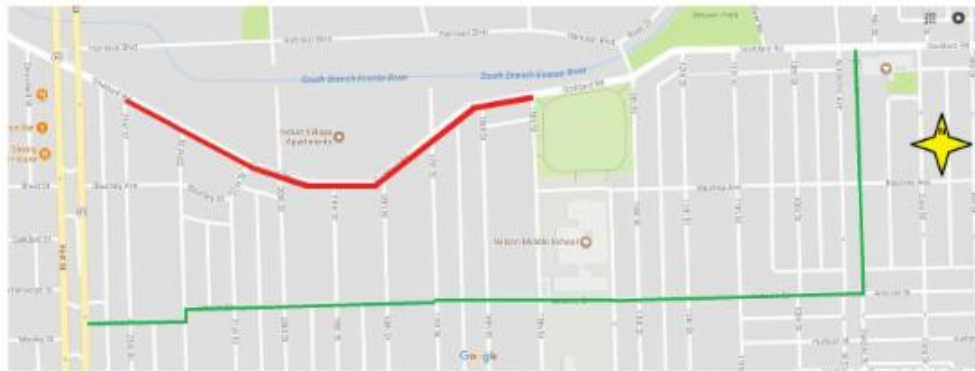

**GODDARD ROAD CLOSURE**

- What:** Eastbound Goddard Road will be closed for concrete pavement repairs from 23<sup>rd</sup> Street to 15<sup>th</sup> Street. Westbound Goddard Road will remain open but delays are anticipated as trucks enter and leave the jobsite and when concrete trucks discharge.
- Start:** Closure begins Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup> 2017.
- Ends:** Goddard Road will reopen on Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup> 2017 or sooner.
- Detour:** Eastbound Goddard Road traffic will be detoured east on Antoine then north on Electric.
- Note:** Residents living on Goddard Road will have access to their driveways unless a patch is required in front of your approach. Others please avoid the area to facilitate a safe and expedient project. No parking on the north side of Antoine Street will be permitted during the project, signs posted.
