

**CITY OF LINCOLN PARK, MICHIGAN
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
EXPECTED FUNDING LEVEL & ALLOWABLE USES
45th PROGRAM YEAR OF THE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

The City of Lincoln Park anticipates receiving about \$791,431 in Community Development Block Grant (hereinafter CDBG) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (hereinafter HUD) for use during the 2019-2020 fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019. Of this allocation, \$633,145 is available to be allocated among various eligible projects. The City anticipates that as a result of its revolving loan fund it will also have an additional sum of funding (program income) available for allocation in the Rehabilitation Loan Program. Any funds received from the NSP1 program will be re-allocated into CDBG funding as program income. The Five-year (2016) Consolidated Plan will govern the allocation of these funds. Federal regulations require that all activities funded in whole or in part with CDBG funds meet one of the following objectives: (1) directly benefit residents with a low to moderate income, (2) prevent or eliminate a blighting/slum producing type of influence, or (3) address a community need of particular urgency for which no other funds are available. A minimum of 70% of these funds must address objective number one. Written proposals for CDBG funding will be accepted by Doreen Christian, Asst. Director of Community Planning and Development, located at 3240 Ferris, Lincoln Park, MI. 48146, telephone number (313) 386-3100, fax number (313) 381-3202, email dchristian@citylp.com through the close of business on January 22, 2019 at 3:00 PM, after which time the Annual Action Plan (Budget) will be completed and made available for public comment. The Mayor and City Council will vote upon the ultimate allocation of these funds. **A PUBLIC HEARING** to provide information on this program, to seek citizen input on community needs, preferences and priorities and to receive project proposals will be held in the John A. Aloisi City Council Chambers on the second floor of City Hall at 1355 Southfield Road, Lincoln Park, MI. 48146, **commencing at 6:30 PM on Tuesday, January 22, 2019.**
