GREETINGS :


Pursuant to Chapter 3 of Title 45 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, you are hereby required to post, at least seven (7) days before the Twenty Second day of May, A.D. 2018 written notifications in three or more public places in the said Town of Little Compton, Rhode Island notifying and warning the electors of said Town of Little Compton, qualified to vote upon any proposition to impose a tax or for the expenditure of money, to assemble in a Special Financial Town Meeting at the Wilbur-McMahon School Auditorium/Gymnasium in said Town of Little Compton, on Tuesday the Twenty Second day of May, A.D. 2018, at 7:00 o'clock in the evening, for the following purpose, viz.:

FIRST

To authorize the Town Council to expend an amount not to exceed Ninety-Seven Thousand (\$97,000) Dollars to fund deficits for legal expenses associated with Eliason/Carlson v. Town of Little Compton et al CA No. NC2017-0241. The revenues are expected to be drawn from a combination of the Indemnification Fund, the Reserve Fund, and the unreserved balance of the General Fund. Allocations from the Reserve Fund will be replenished with cell tower revenues in FY19 and thereafter.

And to transact such other business as may legally come before said Special Financial Town Meeting.
