- [Amended Memorandum of Agreement](#) - "Each county receiving Opioid Settlement Funds must consult annually with the municipalities in the county regarding future use of the settlement funds in the county, including by holding an annual meeting with all municipalities in the county in order to receive input as to proposed uses of the Opioid Settlement Funds and to encourage collaboration between Local Governments both within and beyond the county. These meetings shall be open to the public."
- [Wright County Request for Proposals](#) – “This purpose of this Request for Proposals (RFP) is to identify qualified organizations to respond to the opioid crisis through opioid epidemic response strategies, including prevention, treatment, recovery, and harm reduction. The goal of this approach is to fund projects that will have high impact, particularly for Wright County communities most disproportionately impacted by the opioid crisis. Multiple applicants may be selected for funding contracts. Through this process, up to \$500,000 could be awarded with individual projects receiving \$5,000-\$100,000*.”
