

Be it remembered that at a Regular Meeting of the Luna County Board of County Commissioners in Deming New Mexico, on the 8th day of May, 2019, the following proceedings were had and entered of record.

RESOLUTION #19-24

APPROVING ADJUSTMENT OF PRECINCT BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2019, of the State of New Mexico, enacted HB0407, which included revisions to the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act.

WHEREAS, Section 35 of HB 0407 amends the provisions regarding voting precincts in Section 1-3-1 NMSA 1978, and in Section 38 of HB 0407, enacts new provisions regarding duties of the County Commission in Section 1-3-5, NMSA 1978.

WHEREAS, the aforementioned provisions were enacted as an Emergency and became effective immediately after being signed by the Governor of New Mexico on April 3, 2019.

WHEREAS, the current precinct boundary map showing the geographical boundaries and a word description thereof of the twelve (12) existing voting precincts, namely Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 is attached hereto as Attachment 1.

WHEREAS, the Luna County Clerk has prepared a new precinct boundary map showing the proposed geographical boundaries with a word description thereof is attached hereto as Attachment 2 reflecting seventeen (17) precincts, namely Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 1-3-5, NMSA 1978, the Board of County Commissioners of Luna County endorses and approves the voting precinct adjustments as reflected in Attachment 2 and establishing Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution and attachments shall be recorded in the office of the Luna County Clerk and notify the New Mexico Secretary of State as required by Section 1-3-5, NMSA 1978.
