

Be it remembered that at a Regular Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Luna County in Deming New Mexico, on the 8th day of April 2021, the following proceedings were had and entered of record.

RESOLUTION 21-32

ADJUSTING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES AND CREATING NEW PRECINCT

WHEREAS, Section 1-3-12C NMSA 1978 requires the respective Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerks to adjust all precinct boundaries upon receipt of the standard base maps from the Secretary of State.

WHEREAS, Section 1-3-12D NMSA 1978 states adjustments to the standard base maps submitted and as revised and approved by the Secretary of State pursuant to the provisions of the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act shall become the official precincts of each county for the 2021 redistricting, and

WHEREAS, Section 1-3-1B(1) NMSA 1978 requires a precinct be divided or its boundaries adjusted if the precinct has had more than 750 votes cast based on the two most recent general elections or if the precinct has more than 2500 persons residing within the boundaries of the precinct, and

WHEREAS, Luna County, in Conjunction with the State of New Mexico's approved vendor, for technical support identified one precinct boundary split as defined in the attached Exhibit A in accordance with the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Luna County, pursuant to Section 1-3-5 NMSA 1978 amends the precinct boundaries as adjusted by the creation of a new Precinct 18 in Luna County as designated in the attached as Exhibit A and hereby adopts such changes for the purposes of the 2020 census and for redistricting in 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 1-3-8 NMSA 1978 that the Board of County Commissioners and the Office of the County Clerk shall send a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of State, to the county chairperson of each major political party, and publish this resolution once in the Deming Headlight.

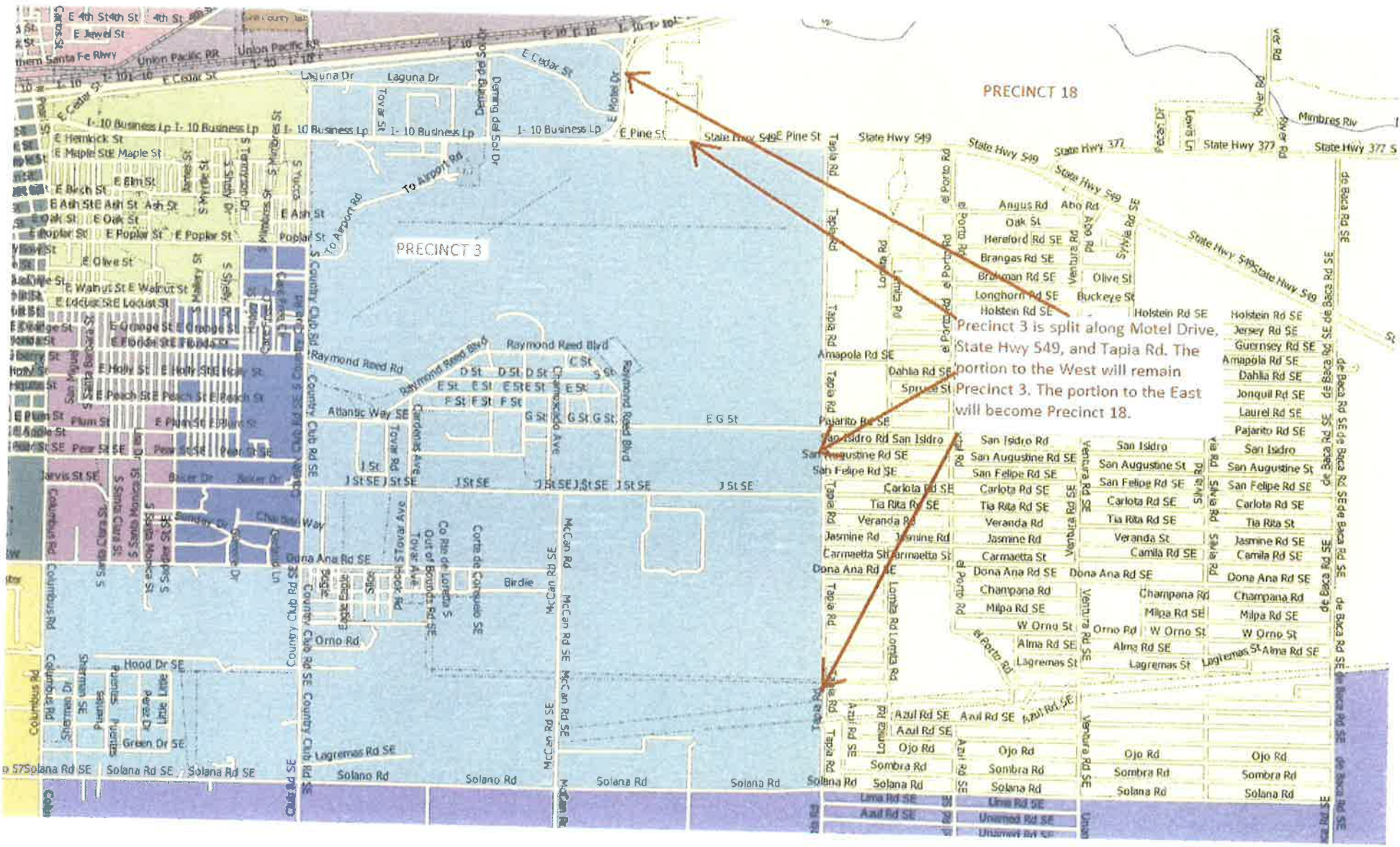
