

Be it remembered that at a Regular Meeting of the Luna County Board of County Commissioners in Deming New Mexico, on the 8th day of May, 2019, the following proceedings were had and entered of record.

RESOLUTION #19-25

PERA CONTRIBUTIONS BY LUNA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Section 10-11-5, NMSA 1978, authorizes affiliated Public Employers to be responsible for making contributions of up to seventy-five percent (75%) of its employees' member contributions to the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA) under certain conditions.

WHEREAS, historically Luna County has paid twenty-five percent (25%) of its employees' member contributions for employees covered under PERA Municipal Police Coverage Plan 5.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to continue such contributions for the Luna County Municipal Employees covered under PERA Municipal Police Coverage Plan 5.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-11-5A(2), NMSA 1978, this resolution is limited to the employee contribution rate in effect on the date of this Resolution and does not apply to any increases in the statutory employee contribution rate, absent subsequent action by resolution pursuant to Section 10-11-15B, NMSA 1978, but in the event of decreases in the statutory employee contribution rate, the percentage of the employee contribution paid by Luna County shall be responsible for making the same twenty-five percent (25%) contribution of the decreased rate.

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 10-11-5, this resolution is irrevocable and shall apply to all employees within Luna County Municipal Police Coverage Plan 5.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Luna County, pursuant to Section 10-11-5, NMSA 1978, hereby elects to be responsible for making contributions of twenty-five percent (25%) of the statutory employee contribution to the Public Employees Retirement Association for the Luna Municipal Members under PERA Municipal Police Coverage Plan 5 effective July 1, 2019.
