RESOLUTION 19-50

EMERGENCY/DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, multiple areas of Luna County, including the Village of Columbus, suffered severe damage caused by severe storms and rain beginning on or about September 9, 2019 and continuing through the weekend ending September 16, 2019;

WHEREAS, extensive damage was caused to several county owned and maintained roads, including, but not limited to, Carzalia Loop, Hermanas Grade, Perrin Rd, Durango Rd, McCann Rd;


WHEREAS, this incident has resulted in undue human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare and well-being of the citizens of Luna County and the local economy of Luna County and the Village of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources available to alleviate the effects of this disaster are insufficient to meet the needs of the situation, make repairs and protect the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority provided by local ordinances and the New Mexico Civil Emergency Preparedness Act, Section 12-16-01 to 11, NMSA 1978, the Board of County Commissioners of Luna County does declare Luna County to be under a state of disaster and emergency for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency powers, for expending local resources, and for requesting aid, assistance, relief programs and funding that may be available from the State of New Mexico.
