Resolution Number 15-41

WHEREAS, the Luna County Board of County Commissioners represents the citizens of Luna County and represent the interests of the County in all matters affecting the health and welfare of its citizens; and


WHEREAS, Luna County has a vested interest in the water and funds allocated to New Mexico under the Arizona Water Settlement Act and has the responsibility to ensure that both are utilized to their full potential; and

WHEREAS, the Luna County Board of County Commissioners has participated as a member of the Gila San Francisco Water Commission since the Commissions inception and recognizes that the New Mexico CAP Entity is the next step in the progression of local government involvement in developing and utilizing the water and funds made available under the Arizona Water Settlement Acts; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Interstate Stream Commission, in open session on June 9, 2015, approved a Joint Powers Agreement under which the local governments from Luna, Grant, Hidalgo and Catron Counties choosing to participate in development of the New Mexico Project will be organized and operated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Luna County Board of County Commissioners in open session hereby establishes its' intent to enter into the Joint Powers Agreement creating the New Mexico CAP Entity.
