

**LUNA COUNTY RESOLUTION 15-57**

**DISSOLVING SAVOY FIRE DISTRICT AND CONSOLIDATING THE FLORIDA MOUNTAIN DISTRICT  
AND THE SUNSHINE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the New Mexico "Fire Protection Fund Law", Section 59A-53-5, NMSA 1978 as amended, authorizes the County Commissioners of any county to establish one or more county fire districts within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Luna County Board of Commissioners established 2 (two) main fire departments which are Sunshine Fire Department with Florida Mountain Substation and Cooke's Peak Fire Department with Savoy Substation on August 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS, upon the passing of this Resolution 15-57, the Resolution 14-42 shall be rescinded; and

WHEREAS, satisfactory evidence has been presented to the Luna County Board of Commissioners that dissolving the Savoy Fire District is in the best interest of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Cooke's Peak Fire District shall remain a main fire department and the Sunshine Fire District shall be the main fire department with the Florida Mountain serving as a substation; and

WHEREAS, said districts have adequate sources of water supply, personnel and fire protection equipment available and the boundaries of the said district being clearly established and being otherwise in compliance with the statutes and laws of the State of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, existing funds from the Fire Protection Fund of New Mexico for benefit of Savoy Fire District shall be expended under the Cooke's Peak Fire District under the direction of the Luna County Volunteer Fire Departments Director and on duly executed vouchers approved by this Commission and shall be disbursed in the same manner as other funds the County disbursed; and


WHEREAS, existing funds from the Fire Protection Fund of New Mexico for benefit of Florida Fire District shall be expended under the Sunshine Fire District under the direction of the Luna County Volunteer Fire Departments Director and on duly executed vouchers approved by this Commission and shall be disbursed in the same manner as other funds the County disbursed; and

WHEREAS, any monies received from the Fire Protection Fund of the State of New Mexico for the benefit of the Cooke's Peak Fire District and the Sunshine Fire District, shall be used only for the purpose specified in Section 59a53-8, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LUNA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, that the Cooke's Peak Fire District shall remain a main fire department and the Sunshine Fire District shall be the main fire department with the Florida Mountain serving as a substation.





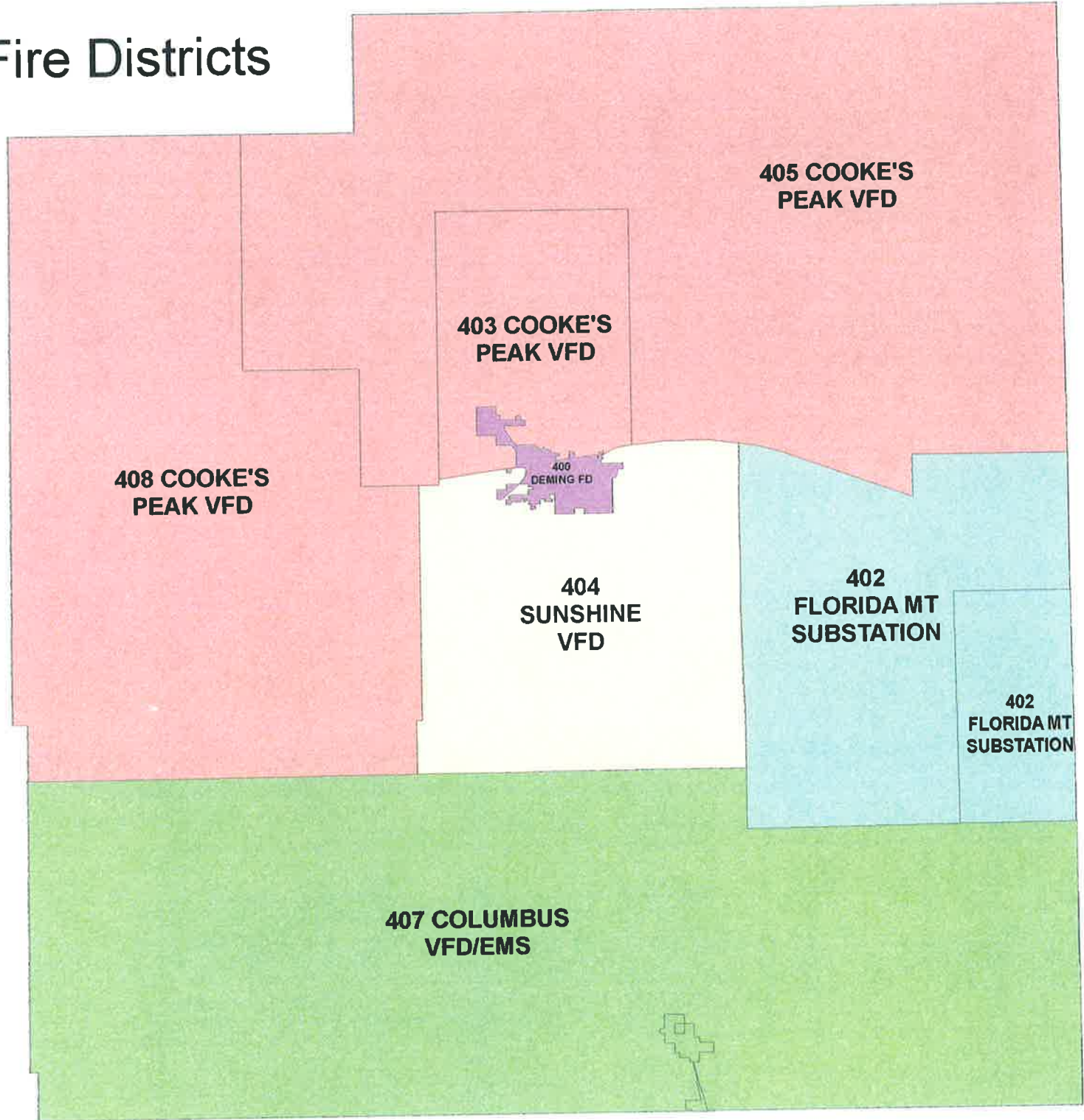
