**Resolution approving the purchase of easement, tax map number 5-10-00-096.00, 446 Edwards Road, Lyman, SC, for \$10.00, with said funds to be distributed from the General Fund**

Brantley Enloe made a motion to approve the resolution with the amendment that

the funds are to be distributed from the Waste Water Fund not the General Fund. Adam Crisp seconded the motion and all were in favor.

**Mayor Greer recognized SC State House Representative Merita Allison present in the audience and invited Representative Allison to give Council and public an update on the actions taking place in the House affecting our District.**

Representative Allison spoke to Council about a project in Startex renovating the metal bridge as an event venue. Additionally, Rep Allison spoke about several funding opportunities the House is working on that could be available to the Lyman area including Act 84 increasing the local government fund, additional funding for the Firefighter Cancer Fund, additional opioid monies. Another item of note is the creation of a State Officer of the Year award.
