RESOLUTION 02-2022R

A RESOLUTION TO PETITION THE AURORA RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO ANNEX THE CITY OF MARIONVILLE INTO ITS BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Marionville, Missouri, previously established the Marionville City Fire Department to provide emergency services to its citizens and;

WHEREAS, the Marionville City Fire Department has provided excellent services to the citizens of Marionville and has had full mutual aid agreements with the Aurora Rural Fire Protection District and;

WHEREAS, it has been determined there is a need to petition the Aurora Rural Fire Protection District to annex the City of Marionville into its boundaries in order to have better and increased coverage and;

WHEREAS, RSMO 321.300 allows a petition with the signatures equal to 25% of the most recent gubernatorial vote in Missouri to request annexing into the Aurora Rural Fire Protection District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Aldermen of the City of Marionville, has determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Marionville, Missouri, to present to the citizens of Marionville, Missouri a petition to determine if they wish to be annexed into the Aurora Rural Fire Protection District in order for the departments to work together to improve emergency services. This petition must include the address of the signers and filed with the Aurora Rural Fire Protection District board.
