Central St. Marionville, Mo. or mailed to PO Box 410 Marionville, Mo. 65705 ALL bids MUST be received at City Hall by February 8, 2024 at 3 p.m. Those not received by that time will not be considered. Bids will be opened and awarded at the Marionville Board of Aldermen meeting on February 8, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at the Conference Room, 101 S. Central, Marionville.

The City of Marionville reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.

#### **BID SPECIFICATIONS**

- 1. The area to be mowed consists of all grass covered areas located within the IOOF cemetery east of Highway 14, near railroad underpass, west of the railroad right of way, and north across Lincoln street including all of the old part, the new part north of Lincoln to Logan Park bounded on the north, and bounded on the west by highway 14 then east to Coleman street. The newly platted area east of Coleman Street to the railroad right of way shall be included in the mowing specifications. All areas bordering Highway 14 shall be mowed on the right of way. A map is attached for clarification.
- 2. The time period covered shall be from the period of April 2024 through October 2024. Additional one-year renewal options- may be exercised at the option of the city. Mowing services will be performed twice per month at a minimum. A provision for additional mowing may be made by approval of the Mayor or by those in charge of the cemetery, depending on the season and growth of grass.
- 3. Mowing of all cemetery properties requires that all areas unable to be mowed, (around tombstones, access areas, etc.) shall be trimmed by weed-eating at the same time as mowing is done. Tombstones and headstones should be blown clean of debris.
- 4. ALL bidders shall provide evidence of proper insurance coverage.
  - a. General liability (premises and operations) \$2,000,000.00 aggregate. \$1,000,000.000 per occurrence.
  - b. Workers Compensation insurance coverage.
- 5. Bidder agrees to not employee an unauthorized alien. An unauthorized alien is an alien who does not have the legal right or authorization under federal law to work in the United States, as defined in 8 U.S.C. 1324a(h)(3).
- 6. Upon receiving the bid, the successful bidder shall acquire a city business license.
