A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARIONVILLE, MISSOURI ADOPTING THE LAWRENCE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION *PLAN*

WHEREAS the City of Marionville recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of Marionville; and

WHEREAS the City of Marionville has participated in the preparation of a multi- hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Lawrence County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, hereafter referred to as the *Plan*, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the *Plan* identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Marionville from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the City of Marionville recognizes that land use policies have a major impact on whether people and property are exposed to natural hazards, the City of Marionville will endeavor to integrate the *Plan* into the comprehensive planning process; and

WHEREAS adoption by the City of Marionville demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the *Plan*
