

## **RESIDENTIAL CITYWIDE CLEANUP**

Residential services for citywide cleanup shall be performed on Thursday and Friday April 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> as coordinated with and agreed upon by, the City and Waste Corporation.

Located on lot between City Hall and the Fire Station, 107 S Central. **Will open on THURSDAY AT 8:00 AM until dark and open back Friday 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

All materials shall be boxed, bagged or bundled and weigh no more than 65 pounds and brought in such a way that a single person could handle it.

The residential cleanup is provided for the citizens of the community and shall be limited to City residential TRASH CUSTOMERS only; no commercial properties shall be allowed to participate in the “free” clean-up.

All/any items collected shall be those items normally disposed of by residential dwellings. Items included but not limited to; clothing, furniture, mattresses, box springs, household products, etc.

Items not included are; construction debris, demolition debris, remodeling debris, car parts, items rejected from landfills (see list below), non-compactable materials such as wood waste, bricks and blocks, rocks or shingles, etc...

RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS

SEPTIC TANK PUMPINGS

SEMI-SOLIDS

SLUDGES CONTAINING FREE MOISTURE

TIRES- (THAT ARE NOT QUARTERED, SHREDDED, OR CUT IN HALF ON THE CIRCUMFERENCE)

WASTE OIL

YARD WASTE- (GRASS CLIPPINGS, TREE LIMBS
