They are working with the avenues available to them to increase the McKean County vaccination sites. We have received very few at Rite Aid and Port Pharmacy. The commissioners understand it is frustrating, but the public needs to work through the existing sites. He also asked that anyone who secures a vaccine, remove their name form other lists. He also noted indicated that there was currently a shortage of donated blood. He said that if anyone has had Covid, they may still donate.
