ORDINANCE NO. 2011-2

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING MONROE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. VIII OF 1963 AND MONROE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1969.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township has determined that it is in the best interests of Monroe Township to repeal, in their entirety, Ordinance No. VIII of 1963, entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY GUN OR OTHER FIRE ARM EXCEPT IN THE NECESSARY DEFENSE OF PERSON OR PROPERTY, WITHIN SIXTEEN HUNDRED (1600) FEET OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTER LINES OF LEGISLATIVE ROUTE NO. 507 (TRAFFIC ROUTE NO. 174) ALSO KNOWN AS CHURCH STREET, AND LEGISLATIVE ROUTE NO. 21028, ALSO KNOWN AS MAIN STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF CHURCHTOWN, MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" and Ordinance No. 2 of 1969, entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION IN SETTING UP THE STANDARDS FOR ROAD AND STREET CROSS SECTION REQUIREMENTS AND FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS AND STREET CROSS SECTION IN MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY DEVELOPERS AND SUBDIVIDERS"; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance and the objections leading to its enactment are authorized by "The Second Class Township Code," Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, No. 69, reenacted and amended November 6, 1996, P.L. 350, No. 60 (53 P.S. Section 65101, et seq.) it is therefore enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. VIII OF 1963

Ordinance No. VIII of 1963 entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY GUN OR OTHER FIRE ARM EXCEPT IN THE NECESSARY DEFENSE OF PERSON OR PROPERTY, WITHIN SIXTEEN HUNDRED (1600) FEET OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTER LINES OF LEGISLA-

TIVE ROUTE NO. 507 (TRAFFIC ROUTE NO. 174) ALSO KNOWN AS CHURCH STREET, AND LEGISLATIVE ROUTE NO. 21028, ALSO KNOWN AS MAIN STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF CHURCHTOWN, MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1969

Ordinance No. 2 of 1969, entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION IN SETTING UP THE STANDARDS FOR ROAD AND STREET CROSS SECTION REQUIREMENTS AND FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS AND STREET CROSS SECTION IN MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY DEVELOPERS AND SUBDIVIDERS" is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3: CONTINUATION

The provisions of this Ordinance, so far as they are the same as those of Ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such Ordinances and not as new enactments. Provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any right or penalty or to punish any offense under the authority of any Ordinance repealed by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance or other Ordinances affected by this Ordinance, it being the intent of Monroe Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER ORDINANCES

All other Ordinances, parts of Ordinances or parts of Resolutions inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.
