Monroe Sewer Projects Update

Planning for the 2023 Capital Project in White Rock Acres is underway with plans to bid the project in December. This project will be in the area of Spring Lane and Deer Road with portions of the main line being replaced, laterals being replaced with cleanout installations, and the rehabilitation of 6 manholes.

We also applied for a Cumberland County Recovery Grant and were recently awarded \$300,000 toward the I&I project work. This grant will allow us to increase the size and scope of the upcoming 2023 project.

During 2022, the Leidigh Pump Station control panel was upgraded and 2 manholes were rehabilitated in the Southern District. The replacement generator for the Northern District has been ordered and will be received in 2023.

A friendly reminder....

What can I safely put down the drain?

There are only three things that should enter the sewer system: human waste, toilet paper, and gray water (water used for cleaning, cooking, and bathing).

What will cause problems and cost me money?

Flushable wipes, baby wipes, facial tissue, paper towels, feminine products, grease, oil, food (not run through a garbage disposal), toys, rags, diapers **risk causing blockages, which means additional unplanned expenses impacting your sewer bill. And, if the blockage is in your lateral pipe on your property, you will need to hire a plumber or an excavator.**
