ZONING/BUILDING:

A zoning and/or building permit shall be required prior to the erection, addition, alteration, use or change of use of any building or structure including grading and driveway resurfacing operations.

A permit is required for the placement, removal or replacement of mobile homes and pre-constructed building. A driveway permit is required for new driveway installations. A highway occupancy permit is required for any work within the Township rights-of-way.

Failure to secure a permit prior to commencing any of the above constitutes a violation of the Monroe Township Zoning Ordinance.

The Zoning Officer's hours are every other Tuesday 8:30 AM - 12 Noon, other times are by appointment only.

- * Private organizations, family reunions, receptions, etc. as may be determined by the Supervisors, will pay a flat fee of \$ 75 for a single (1) day use. Fee for use by non-residents of Monroe Township will be \$250. Security Deposit is \$50.
- * The picnic pavilion is available for use to the rear of the Township building. Single day use fee is \$30 for residents and \$50 for non-residents. Security Deposit is \$50. Picnic pavilion rentals do **not** include or guarantee the use of the Founder's Field baseball facilities.
