**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MONROE TOWNSHIP  
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDINANCE 2020-02;  
REGULATING TRAFFIC IN MONROE TOWNSHIP;  
ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON  
CERTAIN STREETS; AND TO PROVIDE FOR  
PENALTIES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township feel that it is in the best interests of the Township that **Ordinance No. 2020-02** be amended to reduce the maximum speed limits on certain roads within the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance is authorized by the “Vehicle Code,” Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81 (75 Pa. C.S.A. 101 et seq.); and “The Second Class Township Code,” Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103; Act of July 10, 1947, P.L. 1481 (53 P.S. 65101, et seq.); it is therefore enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 5 of Ordinance 2020-02 is hereby amended, as follows:

**SECTION 5: MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED ON CERTAIN STREETS**

(a) Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

2. Brindle Rd. (T-562)	Between the intersection of Brindle Road (T-562) and Clouser Road (T-566) and the intersection of	<b>25 MPH</b>

Brindle Road (T-562) and Eppley Road (T-568)

2a. Brindle Rd. (T-562)      Between the intersection of Brindle Road (T-562) and Eppley Road (T-568) and the intersection of Brindle Road (T-562) and Lisburn Road (SR 2004)      **30 MPH**

47. Clouser Rd. (T-566)      Between the intersection of Clouser Road (T-566) and Locust Point Road (SR 1007) and the intersection of Clouser Road and Brindle Road (T-562)      **30 MPH**

47a. Clouser Rd. (T-566)      Between the intersection of Clouser Road (T-566) and Brindle Road (T-562) and the intersection of Clouser Road (T-566) and Trindle Road (SR 0641)      **35 MPH**

INTERPRETATION AND REPEAL

SECTION 1: CONTINUATION

The provisions of this Ordinance, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such Ordinances and not as new enactments. Provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any right or penalty or to punish any offense under the authority of any Ordinance repealed by this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.

SECTION 3: SEVRABILITY

In the event that any provision, section, sentence clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance or other Ordinances affected by this Ordinance, it being the intent of Monroe Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4: RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER ORDINANCES


