



2023 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

August 04, 2023

Stinson Boulevard/Pleasant View Drive:

This week, the Contractor completed base preparation and installation of the new shared-use trail along Stinson Boulevard/Pleasant View Drive. The Contractor also milled/removed the upper two inches of existing pavement along the roadway.

Next week, the Contractor will adjust existing utility structures in the pavement, with street paving anticipated later in the week. The Contractor will also begin grading and topsoil placement behind the new trail.

South Industrial Center:

This week, the Contractor began spot removal of concrete curb & gutter along 51st Way and the East River Road East Service Drive. Next week, the Contractor will continue concrete curb & gutter removals and begin replacement of fire hydrants along 51st Way and the service drive.

Please note that construction scheduling is tentative, weather-dependent and subject to change.

Street Parking:

In order to provide the Contractor with room to work and prevent any damage to vehicles or personal property, on-street parking in areas of active construction will be restricted, unless otherwise noted, during working hours (7:00 AM – 7:00 PM, Mon-Fri). Vehicles parked within the immediate work area during certain phases of construction may be subject to towing.

Construction

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours upon City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

Resident Access

The City and Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents during construction. Residents can expect to have driveway access during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. We ask that residents, including children, remain outside the immediate work zone and exercise caution navigating the project area wherever you see workers, equipment, or warning signs.
