



2023 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

June 23, 2023

Current Events:

The City's Contractor, T.A. Schifsky & Sons, is anticipated to start construction activities **beginning Monday, June 26th**. Generally, the Contractor will focus on the Stinson Boulevard/Pleasant View Drive project area before transitioning to the remaining project locations.

As construction begins, project residents can anticipate a weekly update and work forecast distributed via the project email list and posted on the City's project webpage.

Stinson Boulevard/Pleasant View Drive:

Next week, the Contractor will begin removal of the existing concrete curb & gutter and driveway tie-ins along the east side of Stinson/Pleasant View in preparation for construction of the new shared-use trail. The Contractor will also perform minor clearing & grubbing of trees and shrubs within the City right-of-way that conflict with the trail construction. Driveway access will be maintained for all impacted project residents with temporary gravel driveway tie-ins.

Residents are encouraged to mark any existing irrigation, sprinkler heads or pet fences near the street to minimize the risk for damage during curb & driveway removals.

As the Contractor begins construction activities, Stinson/Pleasant View properties with mailboxes on the east side of the street will transition to mail service at a temporary on-site mailbox cluster. Additional information on the initiation of temporary mail service and temporary mailbox location will be distributed to impacted properties.

Construction

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours upon City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

Resident Access

The City and Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents during construction. Residents can expect to have driveway access during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. We ask that residents, including children, remain outside the immediate work zone and exercise caution navigating the project area wherever you see workers, equipment, or warning signs.
