Mounds View Tribute Park Project "Walk of Honor" Granite Pavers

One simple way that you can support the project is to order a "Walk of Honor" granite paver for someone that has served our country in time of war and peace, or for someone that served our community as a police officer, fire fighter, or emergency first responder. The proceeds will help cover the cost of this Tribute Park Project, and future maintenance needs.

A custom engraved granite paver 16" x 8" will be a lasting memory to honor your loved ones.

Order Your Pavers Now


After nearly two years of meetings, deliberations and community input, the Tribute Park Committee has finalized the plans, designs, inscriptions, and memorial paver process.

The vision includes construction next spring/summer and formal dedication occurring on or near Veterans Day 2025.

If you want to ensure your loved one will be remembered, order your paver now. The “paver” is an 8” x 16” x 4” thick piece of Minnesota Granite that weighs nearly 40 pounds. These will last forever!

The Spring Lake Park – Blaine – Mounds View Fire Department is in charge of the pavers, send your donation/fee of \$250 directly to them – or drop off at Station One. The \$250 covers the cost of the paver, inscription, as well as providing much needed fiscal resources to make this Tribute Park a reality.
