**REMINDERS:**

- No removal of infected Ash Trees will occur between May 1 and October 31, or until the first hard frost occurs
- Avoid trimming Ash trees from May 1 to August 31

- To prevent the spread of Oak Wilt do not prune Oak trees during the months of April, May or June. If you need to prune during these times, apply a wound dressing to mask the scent of fresh cut wood that attracts the disease carrying beetles
- Avoid trimming Elm trees during early April to late July
- Maple trees can be cut anytime but they do “bleed”, to avoid this, trim during mid-summer or late fall.
