⇒ 7:15pm-Daniel Walczewski

7:45pm-Kyle Thornton

Kyle stated that he has been in the recreation field for the past 15 years and 4.5 years as an Assistant Superintendent of Yorktown. Yorktown has 15+fields, 2 pools and a beach that he manages. He feels that he would be a good fit because he has had over years of experience in the recreational field dealing with many aspects of the Rec. Department.

### ***Superintendent's Report cont....:***

#### ⇒ Halloween Update

Assistant Village Manager, Ken Famulare, reported that there will be Pumpkin Decorating, Saturday October 31 on South Moger Avenue near Citibank, between 11:00-1:00 with a \$5. Fee to offset some of the cost. This program is in conjunction with The Chamber of Commerce. Also, there will be a "Drive-In Movie" on Saturday, October 31 held at Leonard Park. The 7:00pm movie- Hotel Transylvania- would be for a younger audience and 9:00 movie- "IT" for an older audience. This is a *free* program. The max number of cars is 100. Ken also stated that there are at 20 merchants that have signed up for the Annual Merchant Scarecrow Contest and that Wayne and Pat have been delivering the supplies to merchants and everything seems to be going well. The winner of the contest will be announced on Saturday, October 31 at the Pumpkin Decorating event.

#### ⇒ Program Update

Flag Football on Saturdays at Leonard Park is doing well with enrollment. George Price, is teaching basketball instruction for grades 1-3 and 4-6.

There is no: Adult Men's Basketball, Adult Women's Basketball, Adult Indoor Volleyball, and no Adult Floor Hockey.

Liz Dieter, Fox Center Senior Director is offering some programs for the seniors.

#### ⇒ Leonard Park Update

Assistant Village Manager, Ken Famulare, reported that the East of Hudson has completed about ½ of the project in Leonard Park and the project should be completed by mid-November.

There will be early voting at the Memorial Complex Gym, Leonard Park starting October 24-November 1. There will be a bus to transport seniors from the Fox Center to the Memorial Complex in Leonard Park.

(Outdoor)Volleyball Courts have received approval to be redone. Researching the surface that will be used.

The Fox Seniors are using the Memorial Complex Gym for some programs, example Tai Chi because the Fox Senior Center is closed while changing over the bathrooms to be "touchless" during Covid-19.
