FACILITY OVERVIEW

BYRAM LAKE WATER FILTRATION PLANT

- During the month of March the treatment plant produced a total of 41,775,000 gallons for a daily average production of 1,347,581 gallons per day (gpd). Peak production occurred on March 10th, with 1,869,000 gallons produced. The February average production was 1,176,536gpd and the January average production was 1,395,097gpd (Note: Due to the loss of the Controlotron flow meter, we are using the Rosemount back up which is less accurate during night flows.)

LEONARD PARK WELLS WATER TREATMENT

- During the month of March Leonard Park was not used. Total monthly production from Leonard Park was 0 gallons for a daily average production of 0gpd. The February average was 0gpd and the January average production was 3656gpd. The wells are off at this time.

TOTAL WATER PRODUCTION

- The total water production for the month of March was 41,775,000 gallons, for an average of 1,347,581gpd. The February average was 1,176,536gpd and the January average production was 1,398,752gpd

BYRAM LAKE STATUS

- On March 1st Byram Lake Reservoir was at 93 % of capacity. On March 31st, the lake capacity was 93%. The Leonard Park Wells are off at this time.

OVERNIGHT FLOW EVALUATION

- We have attached a spreadsheet evaluating drop in the clear well (CW) levels between the hours of 2:00 and 4:00 AM. The spreadsheet converts the tank drop to average flow rates in gallons per minute (gpm). The March average flow rate was 393.28gpm, the maximum was 926.04gpm, and the minimum was 204.17gpm. During February the average flow rate was 353.91gpm, the maximum was 656.25gpm, and the minimum was 0.00gpm.

COMPLIANCE OVERVIEW

- During the month all State and Federal treatment standards were met. The combined filter effluent turbidity readings were below the 0.3 NTU limit. The highest recorded combined filter effluent turbidity was .157 NTUs and the average effluent turbidity was .121 NTUs.
- March's water quality met or exceeded all State and Federal Drinking Water Standards. A copy of the routine monthly monitoring results collected can be reviewed in the Monthly DOH report that was forwarded earlier this month.

- March 6th- Bedford started taking water.
- March 6th- Reset SCADA #1 screen.
- March 6th- Greased pump at Pump Station.
- March 7th- Cleaned raw water turbidimeter.
- March 7th- Cleaned around polymer system.
- March 7th- Reported rolled up carpet left down next to the reservoir to the Bedford Highway Department.
- March 7th- Water department adding fuel to the tank down at the Pump Station.
- March 9th- Monthly samples.
- March 13th- Replaced static mixer on the polymer system. Flushed the feed line.
- March 13th- Cleaned out the sump pump and pit down at the Pump Station.
- March 14th- Snow removal at the Filter Plant, Pump Station and Leonard Park.
- March 15th- More snow removal.

- March 15th- Bedford stopped taking water.
- March 19th- Blew air into the PCH transfer pipe, blew out a clogg.
- March 20th- Water break around Hillside storage tank. Tank was dropping.
- March 20th- Kinsley on site to replace fuel filter housing.
- March 20th- Water Department replaced 8" line and valve at Beverly and Croton Ave.
- March 22nd- Transferring PCH from one bulk tank to the other. Line is clogged on #2 tank.
- March 24th- Prepped Chlorine tanks for delivery of new product.
- March 24th- Chlorine rinsed Clarifier #2 and #3.
- March 26th- Repaired raw water chlorine feed line.
- March 28th- Low BW wet well alarm. Reset breaker.
- March 29th- Calibrated online and benchtop turbidimeters.
- March 29th- Valve box down at Leonard Park Recreation building failed. Water Department repaired.
- March 30th- Load tested generators at Filter Plant and Pump Station.
- March 30th- After the return to Con Ed power communications were lost between FCP and MCP. Reset everything.
- March 31st- Flushed out polymer system.

FACILITY OVERVIEW

BYRAM LAKE WATER FILTRATION PLANT

- During the month of April the treatment plant produced a total of 36,350,000 gallons for a daily average production of 1,211,667 gallons per day (gpd). Peak production occurred on April 21st, with 1,918,000 gallons produced. The March average production was 1,347,581gpd and the February average production was 1,176,536gpd (Note: Due to the loss of the Controlotron flow meter, we are using the Rosemount back up which is less accurate during night flows.)

LEONARD PARK WELLS WATER TREATMENT

- During the month of April Leonard Park was not used. Total monthly production from Leonard Park was 0 gallons for a daily average production of 0gpd. The March average was 0gpd and the February average production was 0gpd. The wells are off at this time.

TOTAL WATER PRODUCTION

- The total water production for the month of April was 36,350,000 gallons, for an average of 1,211,667 gpd. The March average was 1,347,581gpd and the February average production was 1,176,536gpd

BYRAM LAKE STATUS

- On April 1st Byram Lake Reservoir was at 98 % of capacity. On April 30th, the lake capacity was 100%. The Leonard Park Wells are off at this time.

OVERNIGHT FLOW EVALUATION

- We have attached a spreadsheet evaluating drop in the clear well (CW) levels between the hours of 2:00 and 4:00 AM. The spreadsheet converts the tank drop to average flow rates in gallons per minute (gpm). The April average flow rate was 380.70gpm, the maximum was 561.46gpm, and the minimum was 2.19gpm. During March the average flow rate was 393.28gpm, the maximum was 926.04gpm, and the minimum was 204.17gpm.

COMPLIANCE OVERVIEW

- During the month all State and Federal treatment standards were met. The combined filter effluent turbidity readings were below the 0.3 NTU limit. The highest recorded combined filter effluent turbidity was .179 NTUs and the average effluent turbidity was .146 NTUs.
- April's water quality met or exceeded all State and Federal Drinking Water Standards. A copy of the routine monthly monitoring results collected can be reviewed in the Monthly DOH report that was forwarded earlier this month.

PROPOSED PROJECTS PENDING APPROVAL

In April we took these actions to begin soliciting proposals for the following repair projects. We will present the proposals with our recommendations when the information is available:

Quotes for new raw water Inline turbidimeter.

Quotes for new chemical pumps.

Bids for a new roof.

Plans to replace aging raw water pipe at the pump station.

Be sure to bring the proper documentation:

You will need proof that you are a US citizen such as an original or certified copy of your birth certificate, a consular report of birth abroad or a naturalization certificate. You will also need proof of your identity such as a current valid driver's license or a government issued identification card. If your Adult passport is expired OVER 5 years, you can apply with us by bringing your old passport. If your passport expired UNDER 5 years, you must renew by mail with a DS-82 application. For minors under the age of 16, both parents should appear together and sign the application of the child. If only one parent appears and signs, that parent must submit the other parent's notarized Statement of Consent form (DS-3053) and a photocopy of his/her identification. The Statement of Consent form can be found at www.WestchesterClerk.com.

Fees:

Adult passport fee is \$110.00; Minor under the age of 16 fee is \$80.00. Fees can be paid only by money order or check made out to the US Department of State. Subject: Unpaid Water/Sewer Rents to the Levy on Village Tax Roll

Attached is a summary of unpaid Water and Sewer Rents from 2/1/2022-2/1/2023, with the assessed penalty and administrative fee for levy on the June 2023 Village real property tax roll. The penalty is 10% of the unpaid amount(s) and the finance department's administrative fee is \$20. As done in previous years, the entire amount of the levy will be due on the Village's June tax installment (instead of a split between the June and December installments).

I request that the Board of Trustees adopt a resolution, authorizing the attached unpaid water and sewer rents summary to be levied on the 2023/2024 real property tax roll in accordance with State law and Village Code. Please note that any payments received after the list is adopted and before the issuance of the tax warrant will be removed from this list.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, pursuant to Section 198 of the Town Law and Section 17-1712 of the Village Law, the Mount Kisco Water District (Water District) is administered and managed by the Village Board of Trustees, and

Whereas, the administration and management of said Water District includes the maintenance, operation, enlargement and improvement of said district; and

Whereas, as part of the operation of said Water District, water is provided to properties, for which the Water District is permitted to and does charge; and

Whereas, there exist unpaid water charges on some properties in said Water District; and

Whereas, some of these properties in said Water District exist outside of the boundaries of the Village/Town of Mount Kisco; and

Whereas, the Village Board, pursuant to Section 198 of the Town Law and Section 17-1712 of the Village Law, is empowered to enforce said unpaid water charges;

Now Therefore be it resolved, that any unpaid water charges in the Mount Kisco Water District in arrears of thirty (30) days or longer shall be subject to a penalty not exceeding ten per centum (10%) of the amount due; and

Therefore be it further resolved, that the Board may terminate the supply of water to any property with unpaid water charges if such water charges are not paid within sixty days from the date due;

Therefore be it further resolved, that the Village Clerk, shall file with the Village Board, and with the Supervisors of adjoining towns in which permits have been issued to property owners, statements showing the unpaid water charges in the respective districts and towns and which have not appeared on any such statements previously filed; and

Therefore be it further resolved, that such statements shall contain a brief description of the property upon which the water was used, the names of the persons or corporations liable to pay for the same and the amount chargeable to each, for purposes of levy and enforcement under "Water Rents".
