

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS (65 years or older)**

### COUNTY SENIOR ALL EXEMPTION

Westchester County has passed a local law increasing the senior citizen exemption amounts that are determined by annual adjusted gross income. Previously, in order for a senior to receive an exemption, the income limit was \$37,399. The County's new law increases the limit from \$37,399 to \$58,399.

The process for those already receiving the exemption has been to submit a renewal application and current tax return for renewal consideration of the current Senior All Exemption. Information received for current Senior All Recipients will be used to determine eligibility for the Westchester County Senior ALL Exemption.

If you are 65 years of older and feel you may be eligible for the County Senior All Exemption, the combined adjusted gross income of all the owners cannot exceed the \$58,399. All owners include any persons as noted on the deed. Per the IRS, adjusted gross income is defined as "...gross income minus adjustments to income. Gross income includes your wages, dividends, capital gains, business income, retirement distributions as well as other income."
