Dear Alarm Subscriber:

Reference is made to Chapter 41, Alarm Systems of the code of the Village/Town of Mount Kisco wherein it states that it is necessary to obtain an Alarm Permit for any business establishment or any private residence that has any type of fire, burglar or hold-up alarm.

Section 2 of this law requires you to obtain a permit for any alarm system that generates a phone call, pre-recorded message or any other signal, inside or outside the premises, requiring police or any emergency equipment to respond.

The fee for this Alarm Permit is ten (\$10.00) dollars annually providing it is renewed by February 29th of each year otherwise; the fee is fifty (\$50.00) dollars. (Previously \$20.00) The fee schedule for false alarms is as follows: First false alarm call is free. The second false alarm call fee will be \$100.00. The third false alarm fee will be \$200.00. Each occurrence thereafter will be \$500.00.

Enclosed, you will find an Alarm Data Entry Sheet. Upon receipt of this information and your check, we will update our database with your new information. **It is the responsibility of the business owner or home owner to provide this information yearly.** Changes to this information that may occur during the year must be made in writing and mailed to: Louise Dale, Mount Kisco Police Department 40 Green Street, Mt. Kisco NY 10549. **Be advised alarm decals will no longer be issued.**
