***Review of Income and Expenses (enclosed):***

Charlie reported spending money on repairs for Leonard Park Memorial Pool Complex and Leonard Park. Over all, revenues are ahead of last year- the Pool revenues are a bit slow due to cold spring.

***Superintendent's Report:***

⇒ Conservation Advisory Council- Wallace Pond Restoration, Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup>  
Charlie reported trees planted on April 30<sup>th</sup> - this is to stop geese and run off into the pond. This area at the top left corner of the park entrance will have a new look to it in the coming years.

⇒ Memorial Pool Complex Repairs

Diving Pool - losing water. Charlie is having a company coming in tomorrow to help stop the leaks along the caulk-line. Charlie looking to repair the pool with a vinyl liner in the upcoming fall season. Charlie indicated he will contact the Village Manager on this and hopefully move forward with this liner. This liner has had very good results at the Briarcliff and Pleasantville municipal pools.

⇒ Maple Avenue Playground Inspection (enclosed)

Doing repairs- parts are on order. A couple of rust spots being repaired-scraped and painted.

⇒ Leonard Park Playground Inspection (enclosed)

Some items in the Leonard Park Playground will need further investigations with repairs- such as head entrapment on special slide and other fatiguing connections.

⇒ B.C.S.D. Bike Run – Sunday, May 22, 2011

Will be paying for additional Police costs and clean up cost. This event will be done by noon.

⇒ Camp Iroquois Fire Pit

Waiting to hear from insurance company, through the Village Manager.

⇒ Proposed Future Kiddy Camp (ages 3-5)

Sent application to Mt. Kisco Elementary School for use of the building- but have not heard yes for summer 2012. Principal, Susan Ostrofsky, has the application- it's too early for her to make any decision.
