⇒ Fox Senior Center Exterior wood trim, fascia boards, soffit boards and roof repairs
Capital Project- all of the above- rotting away. Charlie waiting on three (3) estimates.

⇒ Paul Toro email to Recreation Commission about Fox Lane Youth Lacrosse allowed access to the field and he was not. FLYL trying to bring LAX to the Mt. Kisco Community. Roy Sartorius and Charlie will write a response to Paul Toro.
