Wild Flower Seed Packets: We discussed not buying seeds this year and instead use the money towards fixing the fountain. Motion was approved by Pat Reilly and seconded by Joanne Hauser

Fountain Repair: Joanne Hauser volunteered to take the lead in talking to local professionals to see how we can get the fountain into working condition and the costs involved. After that we will discuss the possibilities of finishing off the pipe possibly using an aeration fountain for a lower key effect.

Flower Basket Award for 2019:

A vote was taken at the meeting and the committee selected Stone Fire Grill in a close vote with New England Antique Lumber. Joanne Hauser, Andre Ferrara and Joanne Hack will work together to put together the award.

Decade of Greenery Award:
